- City agencies have developed criteria to prioritize projects for Dogpatch.
- Assessing projects through these criteria will determine how projects will be prioritized for the next 2, 5, and 10 years.
- Input from CACs is needed to make sure we have the right approach and we are focusing on the right priorities.

3

- ▣ Legal Mandate
- ▣ Life/Health Safety
- ▣ Timely Maintenance or Renewal
- ▣ Formal Programs or Objectives
- ▣ Enhancement of Economic Vitality

PROJECT CRITERIA

4

- Common across project types:
 - ADA compliance & accessibility
 - Preserving existing assets
 - Proximity to density

- Streetscapes
 - Pedestrian safety/Vision Zero
 - Appropriate scope for the area
 - Leveraging existing projects
 - Creating a network of streets for pedestrians and cyclists

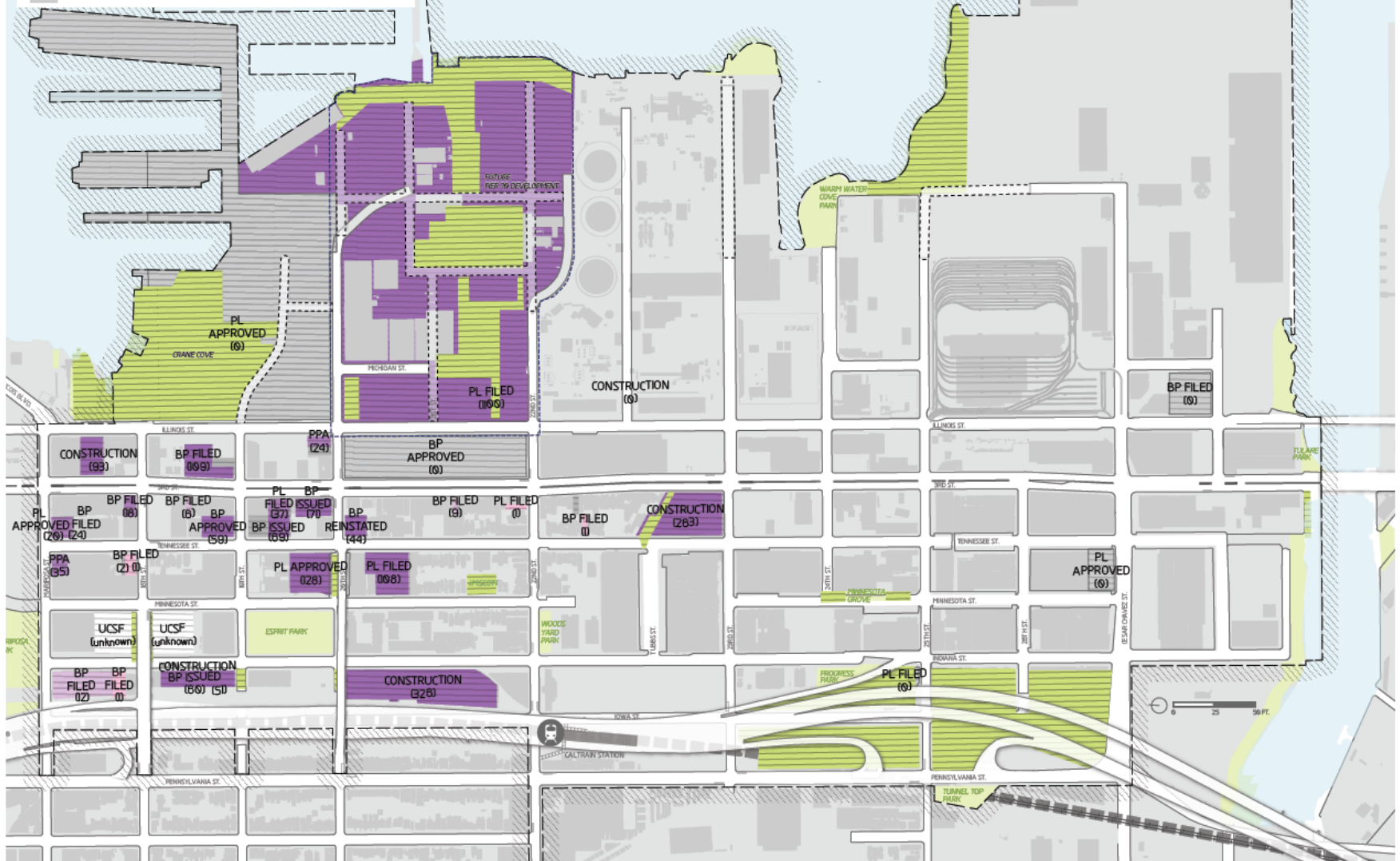
- Open Space
