BACKGROUND

The proposal is to install a wireless telecommunications facility consisting of nine new panel antennas on the rooftop and six new equipment cabinets in the garage of an existing three-story mixed use building that is approximately 30-feet tall. The proposal is part of a wireless transmission network operated by AT&T.

A request for continuance was submitted to the Planning Commission by Supervisor Malia Cohen on July 27, 2011. The request indicated that the Supervisor would like more time to discuss the project with members of the Visitacion Valley community and the Project Sponsor. The various parties agreed to a continuance to the Planning Commission hearing on October 6, 2011.

Since the continuance, a dialogue between the parties continued and AT&T provided a booth at the Leland Street Festival as outreach. Despite the additional communication a resolution could not be reached. The community's outstanding concerns remain health related and Supervisor Cohen continues to encourage dialogue between the community and local Congressional leaders, as well as AT&T representatives.

The Project Sponsor has no additional material to submit. Members of the Community intend to supply the Commissioners with additional petitions signed in opposition to the proposal.

CURRENT PROPOSAL

The scope of work remains the same.

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REQUIRED COMMISSION ACTION

In order for the project to proceed, the Commission may grant the Conditional Use authorization pursuant to Planning Code Sections 303, 711.83 and 790.80, to allow the installation of wireless facilities.

- The Project complies with the applicable requirements of the Planning Code.
- The Project is consistent with the objectives and policies of the General Plan.
- The Project is consistent with the 1996 WTS Facilities Siting Guidelines, Planning Commission Resolution No. 14182.
- The Project is a Location Preference 5, a preferred location, acording to the Wireless Telecommunications Services (WTS) Siting Guidelines.
- The Project will improve coverage for an area where there is currently poor coverage.
