PROJECTS

Sunset District Historic Survey: The Planning Department was awarded a grant from the California Office of Historic Preservation to document the history and significance of builder tract developments in the Sunset District. To date, a historic context statement has been completed with an architectural survey of residential builder tracts underway. This evaluative survey will document the clusters of eligible historic districts and individually significant buildings. Importantly, the survey will also document and evaluate buildings that do not qualify as eligible historic resources. The survey project will conclude in late Fall 2012.

SF Planning is looking for historic photographs, maps, architectural plans, building permit histories or other relevant information.
