ECODISTRICT PRESENTATION	<p>Talk: Ownership Models for Sustainable Neighborhood Infrastructure</p> <p>Trent Berry will review the range of ownership options for neighborhood infrastructure ranging from 100% municipal ownership to 100% private ownership, with a variety of hybrid and alternate models between. He will discuss the critical role for the public sector in establishing the conditions for success and securing public benefits, regardless of the ownership model, paying particular attention to the role of municipalities at different stages of the project / business lifecycle.
