showcase the final street design for Polk Street. The project team developed a streetscape design that will improve pedestrian safety, mobility for cyclists and transit riders, and support overall commercial activity along Polk Street. The final streetscape design recommendations build on the transportation safety recommendations released by the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency in 2013.
